1.) Call to Order

The Concho County Hospital District Board of Directors, at the request of member Anita Aguilar, met in Eden, Texas at the Concho Medical Clinic Lobby, 551 Eaker Street, for a Called Meeting on Tuesday February 3, 2026, at 5:30 p.m.

3.) Public Comments

Lesa Grumbles- Ms. Lesa Grumbles addressed the Board regarding the REH designation, meeting recordings, and communication with the press. She questioned why the media had been contacted and expressed concern that inaccurate statements had been made. She also stated that multiple meetings were being held on the same topics.

Ms. Grumbles expressed the opinion that “Mr. Bob” (apparently referring to Robert A. Pascasio, District Administrator/CEO) had exceeded his authority and should be disciplined, although she provided no specifics. She raised concerns about Pascasio taking notes and preparing the meeting minutes, stating that she believes the minutes may reflect a one-sided perspective. She further stated that wording in the minutes could potentially expose the Board to legal liability, again not identifying or specifying any particular wording.

Ms. Grumbles commented that she feels the Board does not adequately consider input from the community. She also alleged that the Chair acts in the interest of the CEO rather than independently. Ms. Grumbles stated that she maintains recordings of meetings and believes the minutes should be transcribed verbatim. She asserted that her recordings could demonstrate inaccuracies in the official record.

4.) REH Designation

- Anita Aguilar stated that she asked to have this meeting, as she did not understand at the time of the January 27th meeting that the Board was voting to move forward with conversion to a Rural Emergency Hospital (REH) designation, as she subsequently learned from a report in online publication. “San Angelo Live”. She stated that she believed the approval was limited to authorizing Pascasio to prepare and submit the application to the Board for future consideration.
- Brandi Gloria stated that her understanding at the meeting was that Concho County Hospital District (CCHD) would be moving forward with submitting the application to convert to REH status.
- Rosa Schreiber stated that she believed Pascasio would complete the application and present it to the Board at a subsequent meeting before final submission. She also stated that, given the hospital’s financial difficulties, she believes moving forward with REH designation is necessary. However, she indicated that she did not understand that the prior vote authorized immediate submission of the application. The motion on January 27th authorized administration to submit the application(s) to convert Concho County Hospital to REH designation, which passed 4–0.

- Julie Jones stated that approval to submit the application indicates intent to move forward with REH conversion. She further stated that she was aware of the related article, as it was included in the January 27th board packet, but she was not aware of when a press release would be issued.
- Anita Aguilar while acknowledging she had not picked up/reviewed her Board package (Board packages had been made available Friday morning January 23rd) and seen the relevant and related materials until just prior to the meeting of the 27th, Anita Aguilar stated that clearer language should have been used to indicate that the Board was voting to convert to REH status. She expressed that she would like to retract her vote, although she voiced she understood that was not possible.

Disruption and Removal

At 5:40 p.m., while attempting but being unable to respond to Board discussion and questions due to repeated interruptions from Ms. Lesa Grumbles, Pascasio requested Ms. Grumbles be removed due to those continued interruptions, abusive conduct and disruption of the public Board meeting. At 5:44 p.m., Pascasio, through staff, requested assistance from law enforcement after the disruptions continued and Ms. Grumbles became verbally confrontational. Deputies from the Concho County Sheriff's Office and a Trooper from the Texas Department of Public Safety responded and asked Ms. Grumbles to leave the meeting due to the ongoing disruption.

Continued REH Discussion

At 5:50 p.m., the Board meeting resumed.

- Priscilla Aguirre questioned Pascasio regarding the timeframe for withdrawing the REH application. Pascasio stated that once the application is submitted, there is only a limited timeframe in which it may be withdrawn. He reiterated that the application submission had been approved at the January 27th meeting by a 4-0 vote. Priscilla Aguirre asked her question again and when Pascasio asked for clarification, she did not respond.
- Anita Aguilar expressed concern that Pascasio could sign and submit the application to continue moving forward without additional Board direction.

- Julie Jones states that this discussion and topic have been on multiple agendas dating back to August 2025.
- Priscilla Aguirre again asked whether there was still time to withdraw and whether the Board intended to proceed or reconsider.
- Brandi Gloria stated that there is a limited window to withdraw the application once submitted.
- Rosa Schreiber reiterated that from a financial standpoint, she believes conversion to REH is necessary. However, she stated that she believed the Board would have an additional month to make a final decision.
- Anita Aguilar indicated that she had other obligations and needed to leave, even though she is the one that requested the meeting. Priscilla Aguirre noted the same. Both arose, indicating their intentions to leave the meeting when Chair Julie Jones reminded them, a motion to adjourn the meeting was required.

Adjourn

There being no further business to consider the, meeting adjourned at 6:08 p.m.- Motion by -Anita Aguilar, seconded by Brandi Gloria. Motion passed 5-0.
